Benjamin "Ben" Flowers, 33, of Benton Harbor died at his home on Tuesday, April 14, 2015.

Services celebrating his life will be held at 2 PM on Saturday, April 18, at the Blue Roof Church at 3084 Niles Road in St. Joseph. The visitation will be held from 5 PM to 8 PM on Friday at the Blue Roof Church. Cremation will follow the service and burial of the ashes will be at Hickory Bluff Cemetery in Lincoln Township.
