We love you Blake and will miss you until we all meet again in heaven.

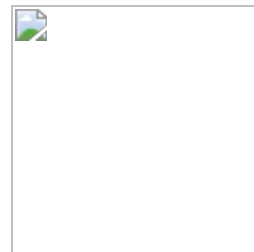
