Bridgman – Catherine E. Pelletier, 91, formerly of St. Joseph, passed away Sunday afternoon at Jordan's Nursing Home in Bridgman.

A life-long devout Catholic, Catherine was a long-time member of St. Joseph Catholic Church and a member of the Alter Society, Marian Guild, and the Council for Catholic Women on the local, state, and national level. From the later, she received recognition for her devotion to the church from Bishop Albers of the Diocese of Lansing, MI. Catherine loved working crossword puzzles, was an avid reader, and enjoyed baseball – particularly watching the Chicago Cubs.

Catherine is survived by her beloved husband of 64 years, Emmet and by a step-cousin.
