Charles "Chuck" Reed, 67, of Coloma died Tuesday, October 4, 2016 at the Select Specialty Hospital in Battle Creek.

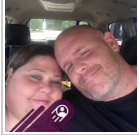

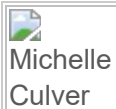

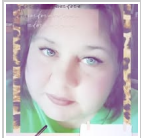
