Charles "Charlie" Shoemaker, 80, of Watervliet died Friday, August 12, 2022 at his residence.

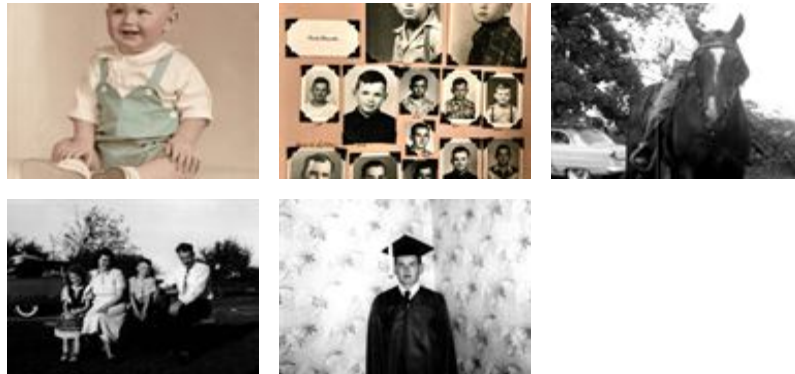
