Douglas Wayne Kiser, 54, of Coloma, passed away Wednesday, March 13, 2013, in Coloma.

Funeral services celebrating his life will be held at 1:00 P.M., Tuesday, March 19, 2013, at the Davidson Chapel of Florin Funeral Service, 249 E.
