Benton Township - Glen A. Sisk, 90, of Benton Township, passed away early Sunday, May 22, 2011, at Lakeland Regional Medical Center in St. Joseph.

Funeral services celebrating his life will be held at 11:00 A.M., Thursday, May 26, at the Davidson Chapel of Florin Funeral Service, 249 E.
