Coloma – Harolyn Ann ‘Ma’ Quigley, 73, of Coloma, passed away early Monday morning, September 20, 2010, at Lakeland Continuing Care in St. Joseph.

Funeral arrangements celebrating her life will be held at 11:00, Friday, September 24, at Faith Evangelical Lutheran Church, 6756 Paw Paw Ave., in Coloma, with Pastor Thomas Schuetze officiating. Burial will follow at the Coloma Cemetery. Visitation will be held Thursday evening from 5:00 to 7:00 at the Davidson Chapel of Florin Funeral Service, 249 E. Center Street, in Coloma.
