Jeremy W. Kennedy, 28, of Bridgman passed away on Wednesday, March 16, 2016, at the Hanson Hospice Center in Lincoln Township.

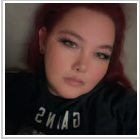

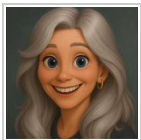
