



## Kyle F. Schick Jr.

November 18, 1921 - May 27, 2012

Kyle F. Schick of Benton Harbor passed away Sunday, May 27, 2012, following a short illness at home.

The family will greet friends Tuesday evening from 5:00 until 8:00, at the Fairplain Chapel of Florin Service, 1053 Napier Avenue, in Benton Harbor. He worked at Ross Carrier and OK Electric of Benton Harbor and preceded to work and then retired from the Benton Harbor Post Office after 27 years of service. June and Kyle were the proud participants of the Michigan "Snowbirds," spending winters in Leesburg, FL for over 14 years. They also loved to spend their retired years traveling the world, including Switzerland, Germany, Aruba, Alaska, Hawaii, and several cruises.
