Eau Claire – Lester J. “Jim” Yerington 66, of Eau Claire, passed away Saturday afternoon, August 6, in Eau Claire.

Funeral services celebrating his life will be held at 11:00, A.M., on Friday, August 12, 2011 at the Fairplain Chapel of Florin Funeral Services, 1053 E. Napier Ave., in Benton Harbor, with Pastor Walter McCutcheon officiating. Burial will follow at Millburg Cemetery.

He was always involved with heavy machinery and worked for many years at Harris Trucking. He owned and operated Jim’s Café in Dowagiac. Additionally he served as a reserve officer within the Cass County Sheriff’s Department. Jim will be remembered for his great sense of humor. He never met a stranger and would go as far to give everyone he met a nick-name. Jim had a heart of gold and was always willing to “do anything for anyone.” Jim cherished his family and was particularly proud of his daughter and grandchildren.
