Lewis Leetz, 90, of Watervliet passed away early Monday, Sept. 13, 2010, at his home.

A committal service celebrating his life will be held at 2 p.m. Friday, Sept. 17, at the Coloma Cemetery with Pastor Billy Long officiating. Military rites will conclude the committal.
