Lorraine A. Deja, 91, of Lincoln Township died Wednesday, January 30, 2013, at Eaton County Care Facility in Charlotte, Michigan.

A Mass celebrating her life will be held at 10 AM on Monday, February 4, at St. Joseph Catholic Church in St. Joseph. Burial will follow in Riverview Cemetery. The visitation will be from 2 PM to 5 PM on Sunday at the Dey-Florin Chapel of Florin Funeral Service in St. Joseph where a Prayer Service will be held at 4 PM.
