Society for 15 years. She was an avid quilt maker through her 90s. All of her quilts were done by hand. She gave them away to her family members and friends. She loved sewing, reading, gardening and her family, especially her loving husband. Lucille's faith in God sustained her throughout her life. She was always giving to others and was loving and supportive of her family. She will be missed by her close neighbors and friends.

She is survived by her daughter, Darlene Pinkston of Lapeer, MI; her 4 grandchildren, Wade (Helen) Whitaker, Dan Whitaker, Craig (Nancy) Whitaker, and Carri (Chris) Ormiston; her 9 great-grandchildren; her 2 great-great-grandchildren; her brother, Irving (Viola) Clark; and several nieces and nephews.
