Margaret Ann Schadler, 81, of St. Joseph died Wednesday, September 17, 2014 at the Whitcomb Towers.

She was a life member of the Benton Harbor First Congregational Church, active in many roles over the years, and served as its financial secretary for 30 years. She loved music and played the piano in her younger years. She also enjoyed attending concerts, especially the St. Joseph Municipal Band concerts on the bluff. Margaret was interested in other people and was always found helping others. She also loved getting together with her family and friends.

She is survived by her children, Steve (Cheryl) Schadler of St. Joseph and Jim (Ann) Schadler of Lansing, and her 2 grandchildren, Benjamin and Amanda. She was also preceded in death by her twin sister, Mary Alice, in 1968.
