February 24, 1935 - April 21, 2013

Mary “MA” E. Callahan, 78 of Coloma, was welcomed home by her Lord early Sunday, April 21, 2013, at Jordan’s Life Care Center in Bridgman. Also “waiting in the field” to welcome her home were her father, Walter and her brother, Jim.

Funeral services celebrating her life will be at 1:00 P.M., Friday, April 26, at the Davidson Chapel of Florin Funeral Service, 249 East Center Street, in Coloma, with Fr. Bill Jacobs officiating.
