Milton Edward Warren, 95, of St. Joseph passed away on February 26, 2014 at The Willows in St. Joseph.

Dorothy preceded him in death on Aug. 3, 2013. Ed was a veteran of WWII, serving in the US Army. He retired from Whirlpool in 1976 after 32 years of employment. Ed and Dorothy were very active in all square and round dancing clubs in the area during the 1950's through the 1980's.
