



## Nancy L Quigley

November 4, 1933 - August 30, 2021

Nancy L. Quigley, 87, of Hagar Township died Monday, August 30, 2021 at the Spectrum Lakeland Medical Center in St. Joseph.

Services celebrating her life will be held at 11 AM on Saturday, Sept 4, at the Watervliet Free Methodist Church with Rev. Brian Hall officiating. Burial will follow in the Coloma Cemetery. She was an artist in several medias, winning several awards at the Berrien County Youth Fair, and was a Treasurer of the Art Guild. Nancy also enjoyed reading. She was known to be a patient caregiver.
