Raymond "Ray" Bujack, 69, of Coloma passed away on Thursday, August 30, 2018 at the Lakeland Medical Center in St. Joseph. Ray struggled with a short, fast and painful bout with cancer.

Services celebrating his life will be held at 11 AM on Wed, Sept 5, at the Davidson Chapel of Florin Funeral Service in Coloma with Pastor Alex Hoffermeier from the Salem Lutheran Church in Coloma officiating. He was an over the road semi truck driver for almost 40 years and was close to 6 million miles on the road. Ray loved to watch old time TV shows like Perry Mason, Gunsmoke and the Wild Wild West. He also enjoyed bowling in his younger years. Ray also loved to fish and watch football. Whenever he could he spent his spare time with his family, friends, and military buddies.

His family includes his sister, Edith (Fred) Munchow of Coloma; his nieces, Lori (Steve) Race of Walker, MI and Lois Allen of Coloma, his 6 great nieces and nephews and his 3 great great nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, Louis and Elsie Bujack.
