



## Raymond E. Struble

February 14, 1923 - July 3, 2010

Millburg – Raymond E. Struble, 87, of Millburg, passed away Saturday morning, July 3, 2010, at Lakeland Regional Medical Center in St. Joseph.

Funeral services celebrating his life will be held at 11:00 Wednesday, July 7, 2010, at the Dey-Florin Funeral Home, 2506 Niles Ave., in St. Joseph, with Pastor John Hass officiating. Burial will follow at Riverview Cemetery in St. Joseph with Military Rites. Visitation will be held from 5:00 until 7:00, Tuesday evening, at the funeral home. Raymond was born February 14, 1923, in Watervliet, MI. He was one of four children born to Vay Charles, Sr. and Lila Lee Struble. They were married May 28, 1945, in Nottingham, England. Six children were born to this union, Rodney, Vern, Sally, Dennis, Collin, and Travis. Raymond worked for 23 years as a Truck Driver for Signal Delivery of which he was proud of his “Accident-Free Record.” Raymond enjoyed outdoor activities including gardening, fishing and hunting with his sons, and teaching many how to swim. Most of all Raymond cherished his wife, family, and grandchildren. “His wife Phyllis was the focus of his life while his children were his passion.” Raymond will be dearly missed by all who knew him.

Raymond is survived by his wife of 65 years, Phyllis; his children, Rodney (Michelyne) Struble of Grand Junction, MI, Sally (Ernie) Gilson of Coloma, Dennis (Lorelli) of Coloma, Collin (Chelia) of New Troy, and Travis Stuble of St. Joseph; 21 grandchildren; 8 great-grandchildren, and by 1 great-grandchild.

In addition to his parents, Raymond was preceded in death by his son, Vern in 1969 and by his siblings, Vay Struble, Vern, and Thelma Struble.
