Robert S. Tysler, 85, of Benton Harbor died Friday, March 4, 2011 at the Lakeland Medical Center in St. Joseph.

Bob enjoyed watching sports and loved his cigars. He was an independent person who lived his life his own way. Bob was a fun guy and was affectionately called "Uncle Bob" by his family.
