Sodus – Robert Glenn “Bud” Peters, 84, of Sodus, passed away Friday, December 18, at home under the care of Hospice of Lakeland and surrounded by his family.

Bud was born in Zion, IL, February 8, 1925, to Joseph and Emma (Now) Peters. Bud graduated from Benton Harbor High School and proudly served with the United States Navy during WWII as a Diesel Mechanic. On February 7, 1948, he married Lenna Johnson in Benton Harbor.
