Rolando M. Fajardo, MD, 77, of Coloma died Thursday, April 22, 2010, at his home.

Services celebrating his life will be held at 11 AM on Monday, April 26, at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Watervliet. Burial will follow in St. Joseph Catholic Cemetery in Watervliet.
