



## Rosemary Lomacz

March 10, 1924 - January 28, 2013

Rosemary Lomacz, 88, of St. Joseph died Monday, January 28, 2013 at the Lakeland Continuing Care in St. Joseph.

A Mass celebrating her life will be held at 1:30 PM on Friday, February 8, at the St. Joseph Catholic Church in St. Joseph. Burial will follow in Spring Run Cemetery in Royalton Township.
