



## Roy Bachman

May 13, 1921 - September 24, 2010

Roy Bachman, 89, of Coloma, passed away early Friday morning, September 24, 2010, at Lakeland Regional Medical Center in St. Joseph.

Funeral services celebrating his life will be held at 1:00 Tuesday, September 28, at the David Chapel of Florin Funeral Service, 249 E. Center Street, in Coloma with Pastor William Chu officiating.
