Susan Lee Tibbitts Fitz passed away Sunday morning, August 26, 2012, following a long and courageous battle with cancer. Society, and working with her 4-H Llama Group. She and Ron established their Crystal Cove Farm, home to a happy mix of animals, including llamas, peacocks, and swans.
