She was a kind, caring, and independent individual and her greatest joy came from spending time with her family.

Her family includes her children, Mark Smith and Victor Smith, Jr., both of St. Joseph, her grandchildren, Aaron, Katerina and Brian Benitez; her great grandchild, and her sister, Maria in Lithuania. She was also preceded in death by her son, Michael Smith, in 1995 and her daughter, Karen Benitez, in 2014.
