Virginia F. Brink, 92 formerly of Watervliet, passed away early Wednesday, February 22, at Caretell Inns of Royalton in St. Joseph.

Funeral services celebrating her life will be held at 11:00 A.M., on Saturday, February 25, at the Watervliet Free Methodist Church, 7734 Paw Paw Ave., in Watervliet, with Pastor Brian Hall officiating. Burial will follow at Baiers Cemetery in Bainbridge Township. Visitation will be held from 10:00 until the time of the service, Saturday, at the church. Virginia was a long-time care giver to her husband Dwight prior to his passing in 2000.
