Wilbur R. Long, 88, of Coloma died Thursday, June 20, 2013, at the Lakeland Regional Medical Center in St. Joseph.

He was a member of the Lake Shore Masonic Lodge and the Coloma American Legion. Wilbur was a truck driver for Tucker Freight Lines for 28 years before retiring in 1982. He enjoyed gardening and working with his hands around the house. Wilbur was the most generous, giving, kind and loving person to his family and his friends.
